

Congratulations to Sergio (Checo) and Angel for their excellent showing in the Rosarito to Ensenada race Saturday. Checo finished the ride in 4 hours 14 minutes and was ahead of many of the bicycles ridden by able-bodied riders. He finished 108th in a field of 8,000+ riders. Angel's best time ever was 4 hours 45 minutes in a previous race.

Our friend, Peter, was able to see him transition from the ocean to the hillside which is about half way. Angel asked him to go down to the race course and help Checo if necessary as he remembered he had a hard time on the first hill. Checo went right by him without need of help and looked strong.
